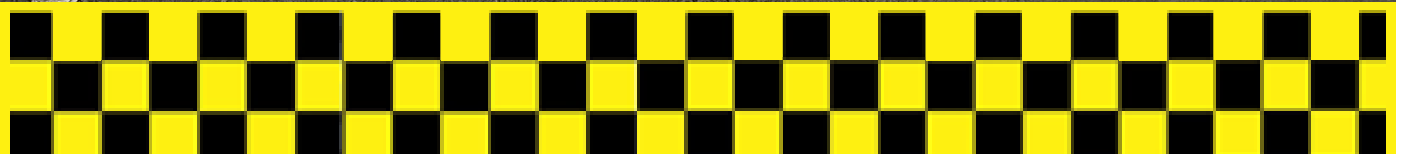

A perfect Spring day had sprung on arrival at the circuit a bit before 7am after a pre-dawn start. This being the day prior to the annual Shannons Day, we weren't able to use the garages while the carports had already been taken. After claiming a space in the paddock, I was joined by Les Payne (MG Midget) and Andrew McLaughlin (Sylva J15) while Craig Barney (Mazda MX5) was nearby sharing a space with his Supersprint buddy in a new Porsche Cayman GT4. Somewhat later, Ray McLachlan (Toyota 86 GTS) arrived just in time for scrutineering and his first run. Apparently, a mix up on which day the event was on was fixed by a phone call reminding him that it was on Saturday, not Sunday. All good - we now had a full roll-up of SCCA runners!

Most of the SCCA runners were able to complete four eight-minute runs around the Gardner (aka GP) circuit and as best I could tell, were pretty happy with their times. Not having run on this circuit since 2018 I was happy to take a second off my previous best time - but have got to acknowledge the contribution of the car that overtook me...

Andrew McLaughlin has really got his Honda-engined UK Kitcar, the Sylva J15, going well and recorded the best time of our group at 1min 50.5sec.

As expected, the camaraderie and craic with fellow club members is what topped off an excellent Supersprint day so if you're thinking about competing, make the effort and come to the next CSCA event on 22 October at SMSP North Circuit.

We also met Giovanni, who came along to pick up some regalia items. The new range is proving to be popular. If you would like any regalia, please let me know so we can order for you.

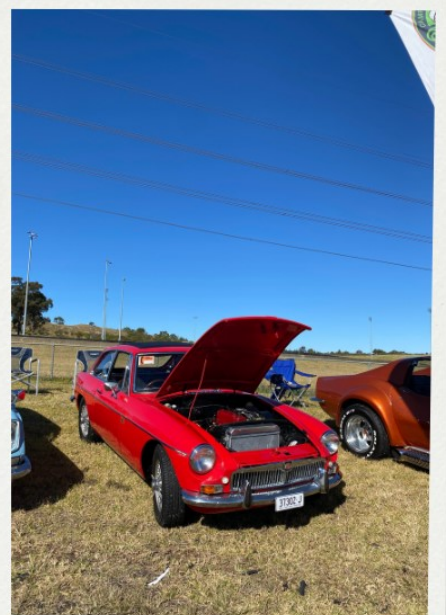
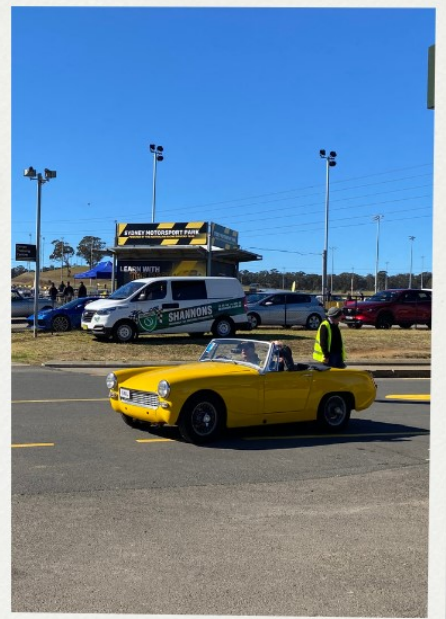

## 2023 All British Day Entry Guide

Enter via Masons Drive and follow the blue snake. At points 2-6 Marshalls will direct you according to the colour of your ticket.

Once on the field, there will be people who can assist finding your club's area. The latest version of the layout map will be on the website the night before and should include any changes that may happen during setup. We recommend that you print that map out or familiarise yourself with it.

Please make sure you know the name of your club- "the Austin Club" is not necessarily enough information!

**At 1:** Any vehicle without a ticket will be directed out of the line and there will be plenty of space to park and sort out your ticket and display area.

**At 2:** C-Yellow and D-Aqua will turn left; B-Blue and A & F-Red and Jaguar-Green will turn right.

**At 3:** C-Yellow turn right, D-Aqua straight ahead.

**At 4:** D-Aqua turn right.

**At 5:** B-Blue turn left.

**At 6:** A, F, & Jaguar-Green turn right.

**1-Yellow Marshalling Area**  
Any vehicle that does not have a ticket will be directed out of the queue at this point ensuring ticketed vehicles will be able to keep moving.

Turn right just before the roundabout  
There will be a sign!

**NOTE**  
There are always last minute changes so please follow the Marshalls.

**REMEMBER**  
You MUST have your ticket on the windscreen. Peel off the backing and it will magically attach to your screen with out adhesive. If you are bringing your car in on a trailer place the ticket on the tow vehicle. You can park around the back of the school take the ticket off the tow car and put it onto your exhibit vehicle and enter the fields. Please be prepared to wait when moving around the grounds in busy periods.
